**CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW – 14TH MARCH 2009**

I would like to firstly thank the Northern SBTC for inviting me to judge at your Championship Show, this was my 2nd judging appointment overseas having judged in Melbourne the weekend before. Also want to thank all those people who looked after me and showed me around some of the north island, it certainly will not be my last visit, as I have made some lifelong friends. On the day of the show I found all the exhibitors and spectators very friendly and the dogs were all well behaved. I try to make everyone and the dogs feel at ease and make it fun although serious. Thank you to the many exhibitors and spectators comments I received after my judging. I found the dogs on the whole to be very good although my co judge would say the opposite. I like to see a standard dog not to bully and not to terrier, with dark eyes, correct scissor bite and correct pigmentation. I did find that there were a few light eyes and some very bad mouth faults – cutting down canines, and undershot is not accepted even in the UK, also black and tans would certainly not be placed in the UK. The dogs/bitches with these faults should not be bred from as they can be passed from generation to generation, surely it would be better to breed from a litter sister/brother that may not be a champion but have correct bite, eye colour etc, to move the breed forward. Those animals that did have bad mouths, eye colour could have been placed if these faults were not present as they did have some excellent qualities. Also there were in some classes some dogs that were not placed that had excellent qualities and it came down to 'nit picking' for my first 3. It also came to my attention that it is difficult to buy a puppy outright without having restrictions on the puppy, either can't show or breed from . I would be proud of any my stock being shown and doing well in the ring, and being bred from as this can only better the breed. It is how many of us UK judges first started in Staffies buying a puppy and being encouraged to show it... Thank you all once again for your kind support and I hope that the comments I have made give you food for thought and that the comments below show that I did see a lot of qualities.

**Baby Puppy Dog**

1. Warfare Pimp Diddy – 3month old black brindle with straight front, dark eye, neat ears short coupled, pronounced stop and good skull to muzzle ratio and not to tall for age, Didn't look at the mouth as a little bit shy and teething, had lovely expression, moved ok.
2. Warfare Q Peds Arrow – 3 month old black brindle with straight front, dark eye, pronounced stop, good width of skull to muzzle ratio, having neat ears, short coupled and had lovely expression, again mouth not looked at due to shyness and teething.



3. Whitestaff The Next Crusader – 3 month old, having nice eye, neat ears, slightly taller than first two places, bit more excitable, but should calm with age, slightly longer in the body the previous placings, All three baby puppies should progress well, subject to mouths being ok and not getting to tall.

### **Puppy Dog**

1. Bustabones Dushlanach (Imp Aust) – black brindle, clean scissor bite with dark eye, neat ears, strong in head and muzzle and having distinct stop, straight front, short coupled, level topline on the move, good bend of stifle, moved well
2. Warfare Outlaw – black brindle with dark eye, neat ears, broad skull, muzzle broad but longer giving more of a terrier look, clean scissor bite, short coupled, bit heavy on the shoulders, good bend of stifle, level topline on the move, moved well.
3. Whitestaff The Highway Man – black brindle with clean scissor bite, neat ears, broad skull and broad muzzle but longer in foreface then previous, good bend of stifle, handled well.

### **Junior Dog**

1. Dimon Zigmaster (Res Dog CC) – this dog caught my eye when he entered the ring, fantastic head shape, broad muzzle, clean scissor bite, neat ears, dark eye, short coupled strong backend, having ample bone, straight front, good depth of brisket, put together well and balanced. This dog thoroughly deserved the Res Dog CC. Well done.
2. Ch Neworder Black Smith (Imp Aust) – black brindle again strong in head and muzzle, having clean scissor bite, neat ears, straight front, good depth of brisket, level topline, good movement behind, moved ok.
3. Blookstaff Buggy Malone – black brindle, having white toes on front, good width of skull and muzzle, neat ears, clean scissor bite, good front and depth of brisket, level topline and moved soundly

### **Intermediate Dog**

1. Kidsgrove Buck Rogers – black brindle, having neat ears, broad skull, dark eye good width of muzzle, clean scissor bite, good front, short coupled, well laid shoulder, level topline and moved well.
2. Ch Rojeme MC Hammer – beautiful mahogany brindle dog, having good strong skull, and width of muzzle however, a little longer in forefare giving a terrier type expression, have nice round eye, a bit wide in front, but short coupled and moved well.
3. Braveangels Flyforever (Imp Big) Losh – black brindle, having neat ears, good width of skull and muzzle, short coupled, good depth of brisket, clean scissor bite. Moved well.



### **NZ Bred Dog**

1. Ch Challenger Hang Em High – beautiful black brindle, shown in excellent condition, having broad skull and muzzle, clean scissor bite, dark eye, neat ears, straight front, short coupled and well laid shoulders, level topline and moved with purpose, fought hard for reserve CC.
2. Whitestaff The Showman – black brindle, dog having neat ears, bit to terrier for me both in head and muzzle, had clean scissor bite and dark eyes, good depth of brisket, and bend of stifle and good front. Moved and handled well.

### **Veteran Dog**

1. Ch Warfare Cylone Sigh – brindle dog in good condition for age, having neat ears, strong skull and good width of muzzle, clean scissor bite, good depth of brisket, well muscled and level topline a credit to his breed.
2. Ch Rojeme Ladys Man – another dog shown in good condition, having neat ears, dark eye, clean scissor bite, straight front, showing signs of age with a slightly grey muzzle good front and well muscled rear end, moved soundly.
3. Westwood Road Runner – red dog with black mask, having dark eye, neat ears, broad skull, good mouth carrying a little of weight but well toned and moved well. The veteran dogs were a joy to judge.

### **Open Dog**

1. Wyrefare Dazzler (Imp UK) (Dog CC) & Best IN Show – this dog is a credit to the breed, having all the qualities a staffie should have, beautiful head shape, width of muzzle, dark eye, clean scissor bite, good straight front, good depth of brisket, level topline, neat ears, distinct top, put together well and balance, good rear end, alert and on his toes, fully deserved dog cc and best in show.
2. Ch Warfare Little Mustateer – another good black brindle shown in excellent condition, neat ears, dark eye, good width of skull and muzzle, clean scissor bite, good front and shoulder, short coupled and good rear end. Moved well.
3. Ch Oakstaff Hot Shot – fantastic mahogany brindle having, good strong skull, and muzzle, neat ears, good front, and depth of brisket, good bend of stifle, level topline and nice round eye. Move well. These placings could easily have been reversed. Good strong class

### **Baby Puppy Bitch**

1. Rojeme Bee Poppalulla - 3month brindle having neat ears, dark eye, nice expression good width of skull and muzzle, distinct stop straight front, short coupled and moved well. Mouth not checked due to age
2. Warfare Pussycat Doll - 4 month brindle a little taller than 1st place, but having neat ears, dark eye, good mouth, good muzzle and broad skull, with distinct stop straight front, moved well.
3. Whitestaff Take A Chance On Me - 3 months and very playful, had beautiful expression, nice head and muzzle, neat ears, short coupled and one that should do well once she has calmed down. Again these puppies should do well.

### **Puppy Bitch**

1. Westwood Dream On Black Girl (Best Puppy In Show) -black brindle, having good head shape, neat ears, dark eye, nice expression, nice front, correct bite, deep stop and good width of skull to muzzle, straight front, well laid shoulder, short coupled and level topline on the move, deserved Best Puppy In Show, one to watch for in the near future.
2. Warfare Opti Miss Prime - black brindle, having good width of skull but muzzle a little long giving terrier expression, ears a little flyty, correct mouth and dark eye, good front, and level topline short coupled and move well.
3. Whitestaff Not White Just Right - black brindle with white blaze, neat ears, good head, distinct stop and width of muzzle, deep brisket, and short coupled, level topline and moved well.

### **Junior Bitch**

1. Surestaff Ucan Do It Too (Imp UK) (Res Bitch CC) black brindle having clean scissor bite, neat ears, dark eye, excellent head shape, width to skull and muzzle ratio, put together well and balanced. Shown in super fit condition moved freely and with of drive, this bitch fought hard for best bitch could so easily have been different on another day. A pleasure to judge her.
2. Bigblock Joint Venture - beautiful mahogany brindle shown in superb condition, with fantastic head shape and distinct stop and width of muzzle, having round eye, clean scissor bite, straight front, level topline and move freely and with drive. Her height let her down for me as she was too topsize for my taste. Still a credit to her owners.
3. Bigblock Legally Wed - again another topsize bitch for me, but still a good bitch with good head, and muzzle, clean scissor bite, neat years, dark eye, straight front, good bend of stifle, level topline, moved well.



### **Intermediate Bitch**

1. Ch Dimon Been Behavin – red bitch with good head shape, ears let her down, however, had good feminine expression, well defined stop and good width of muzzle with black mask, clean scissor bite good straight front, well and bend of stifle and level topline and well muscled moved freely. Well handled.
2. Ch Alerick Dam Right Im White – white pied bitch with good strong skull, neat ears, dark eye, clean scissor bite, good width of muzzle, straight front, well laid shoulder, level topline and moved well for her handler.
3. Willpower Bossy Boots – another good bitch with good head shape, near ears, dark eye, good width of muzzle, good straight front and good depth of brisket, level topline and bend of stifle, moved well,

### **NZ Bred Bitch**

1. Challenger Charlotte Badger (Bitch CC) mahogany brindle bitch that had plenty of class, beautiful head shape, neat ears, dark eye, good strong muzzle with distinct stop, clean scissor bite, straight front, well laid shoulder, level topline and bend of stifle, shown in fit condition, moved well for her handler, a pleasure to judge her, deserved the bitch cc.
2. Gold Merit Ch Warfare Harem Scarem – beautiful brindle bitch with beautiful head, neat ears, dark eye, good width of muzzle for foreface a little more terrier than first place, good straight front, good depth of brisket, level topline on the move, and moved freely and with drive, a little to tall for me but still an excellent quality bitch, a credit to her owner.
3. Renegade Witches Brew – red bitch with black mask, again topsize but having good strong head, neat ears, dark eye, correct bite, good width of muzzle to head ration, good straight front with well laid shoulder, moved well.

### **Veteran Bitch**

1. Ch Rockstock Red Arizona – red and white pied bitch and in excellent condition for her age, neat ears, dark eye, teeth good for age still has good head shape and width of muzzle, straight front, well laid shoulders, level topline and shown in good fit condition. Has all the qualities and virtues that a staffie bitch should have.
2. Ch Warfare Coyote Ugly – another shown in good fit condition, bit taller than first place, but having good strong head but muzzle a little longer giving terrier expression, neat ears and dark eye, teeth in good condition for age, straight front and well laid shoulder, moved well .

### **Open Bitch**

1. Rowbust Solitaire (Imp UK) – what a bitch in what was a difficult class to call, although topline, she has a fantastic head, with beautiful ears, and good width of muzzle to head ratio, lovely expression, dark eye, clean scissor bite, good straight front, well laid shoulder, level topline but longer in the body than I would like due to height. Strong backend, well muscled, having good overall balance, could easily have got the cc but a little tall for me.
2. Hellfyre Foreign Affair (Imp Aust) – another good quality bitch brindle with white blaze, having neat ears, dark eye, good width of skull to muzzle ratio, good straight front, good shoulders, level topline, good rearend and good depth of brisket, moved well,
3. Ourgang Been Around Th Block (Imp Aust) – red bitch with good head shape, round eye, neat ears. Black mask and correct bite, a little topheavy on the shoulders, but short coupled and good bend of stifle, moved well.
